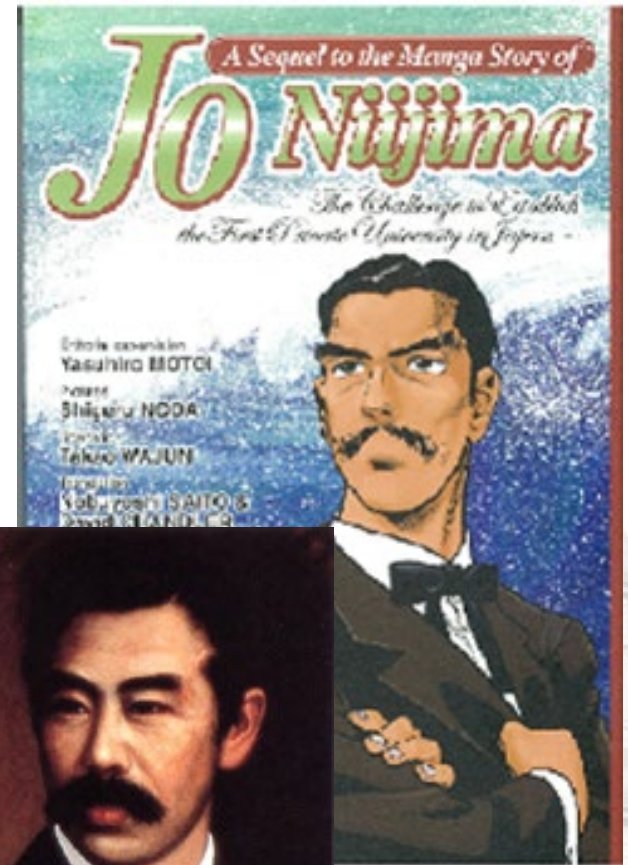
HISTORY OF DOSHISHA

Established in **1875** in **KYOTO**,
by **Joseph Hardy Neesima (Jo Nijima)**, who was:

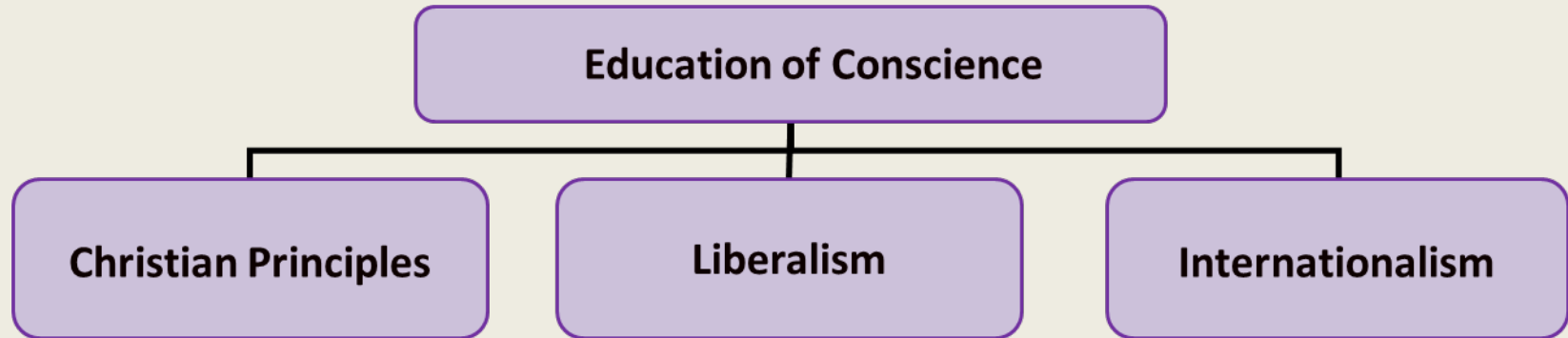
- > son of a **SAMURAI**
- > violated a ban and **risked his life** to study in the **U.S.**
- > **FIRST** Japanese to receive a degree from Western higher education
- > obtained **Bachelor of Science** degree from **Amherst College**

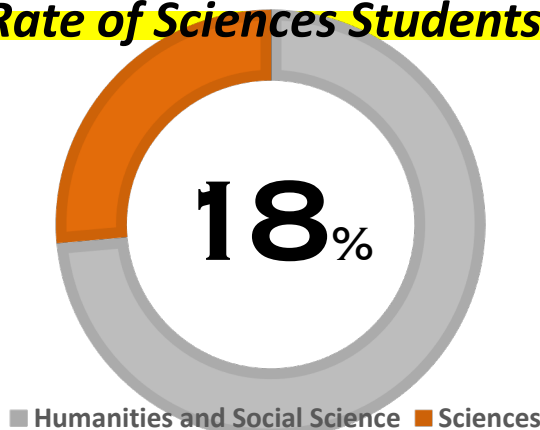

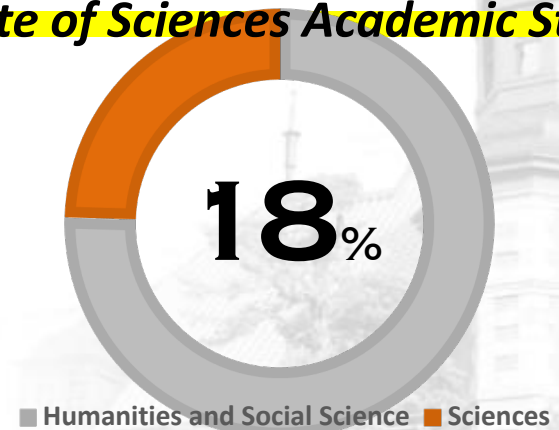

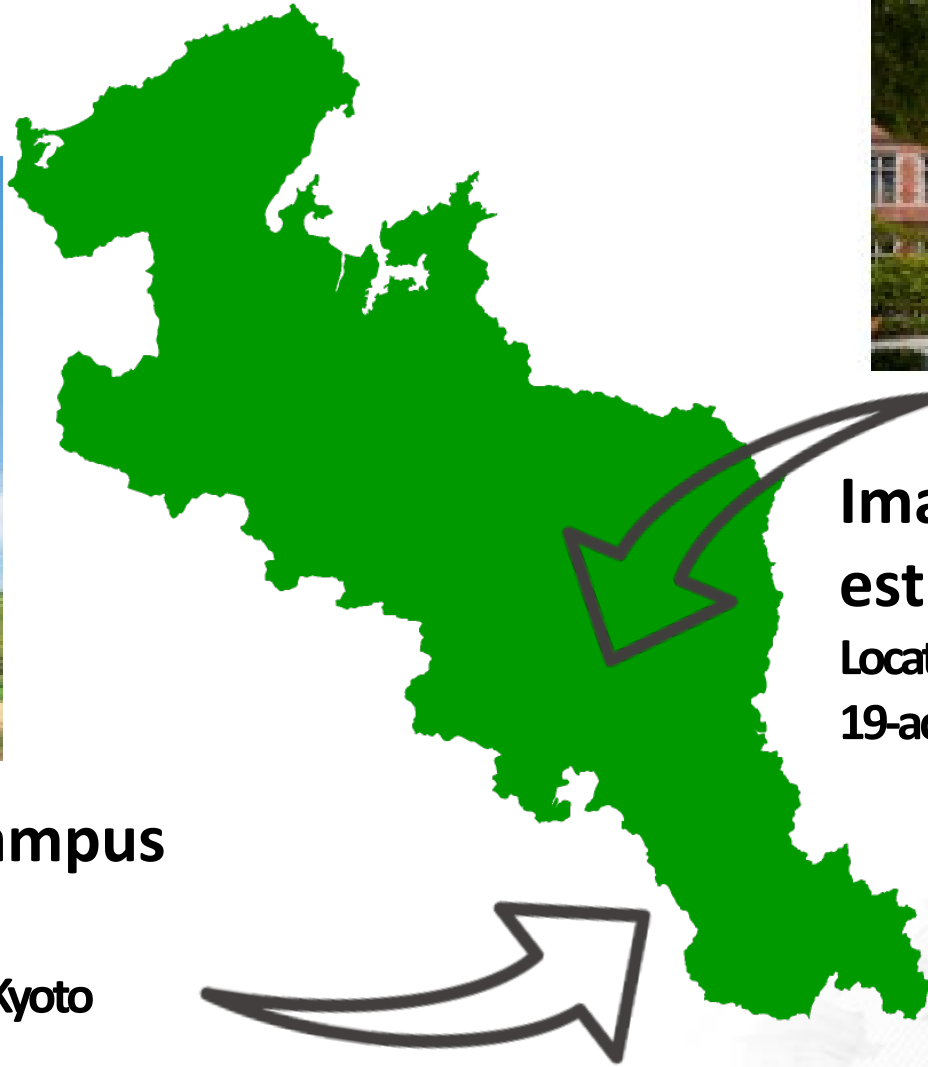


Kyotanabe Campus

Imadegawa Campus

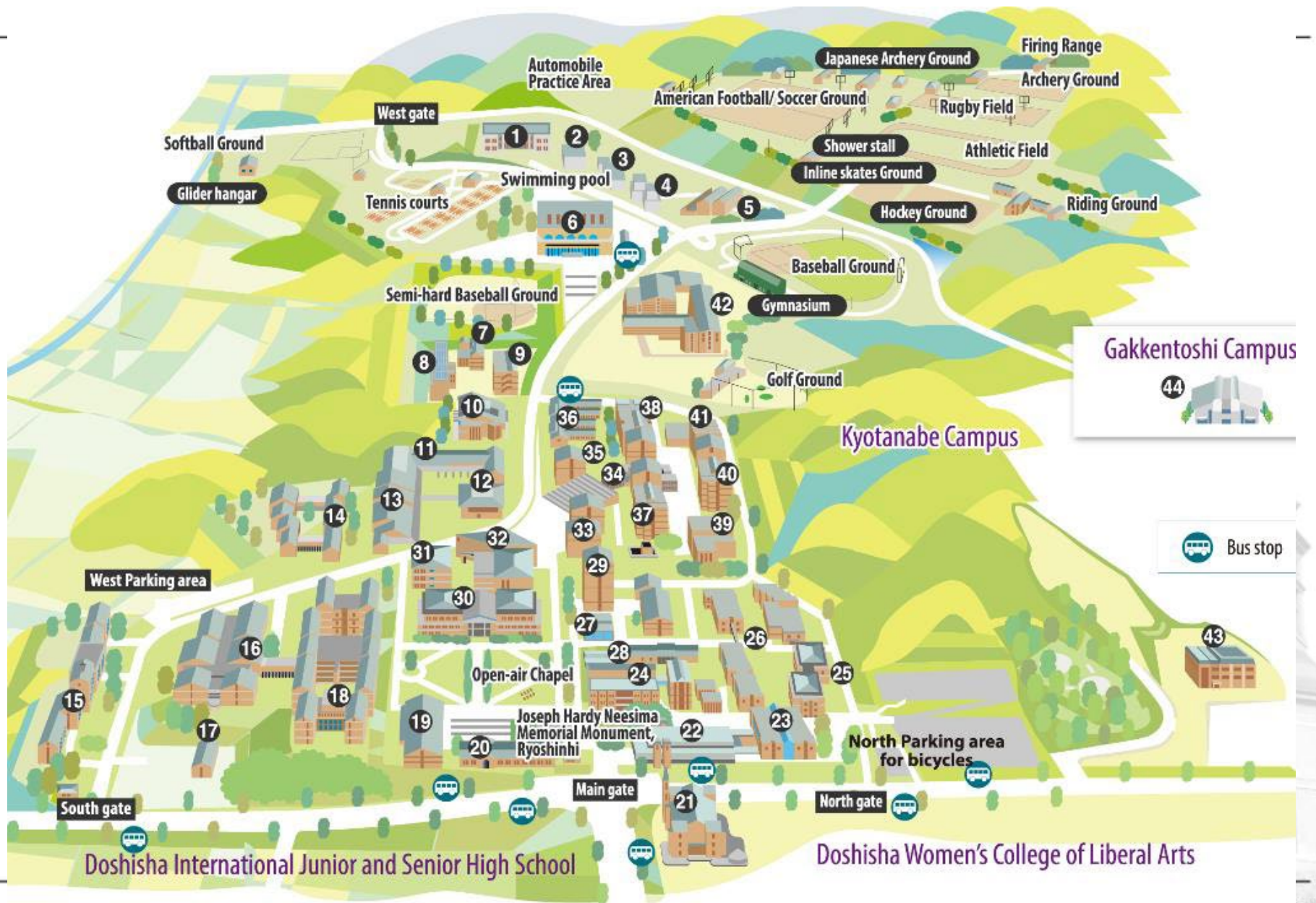

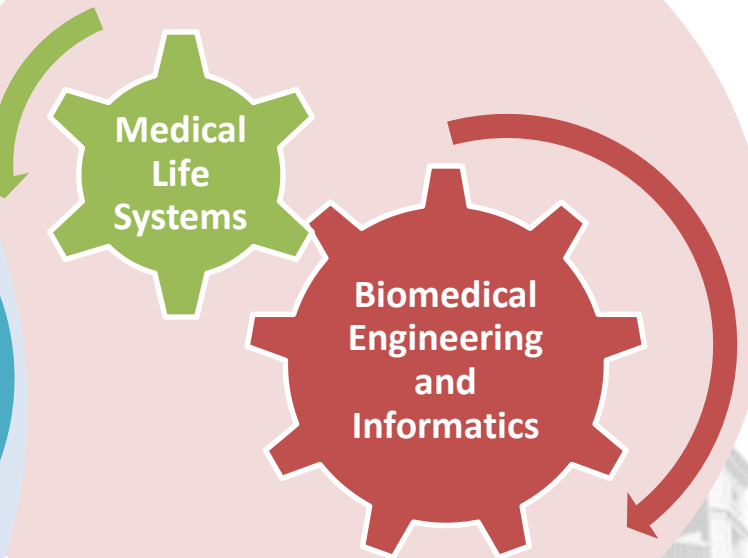
INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY COURSE (1)

INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY COURSE(2)



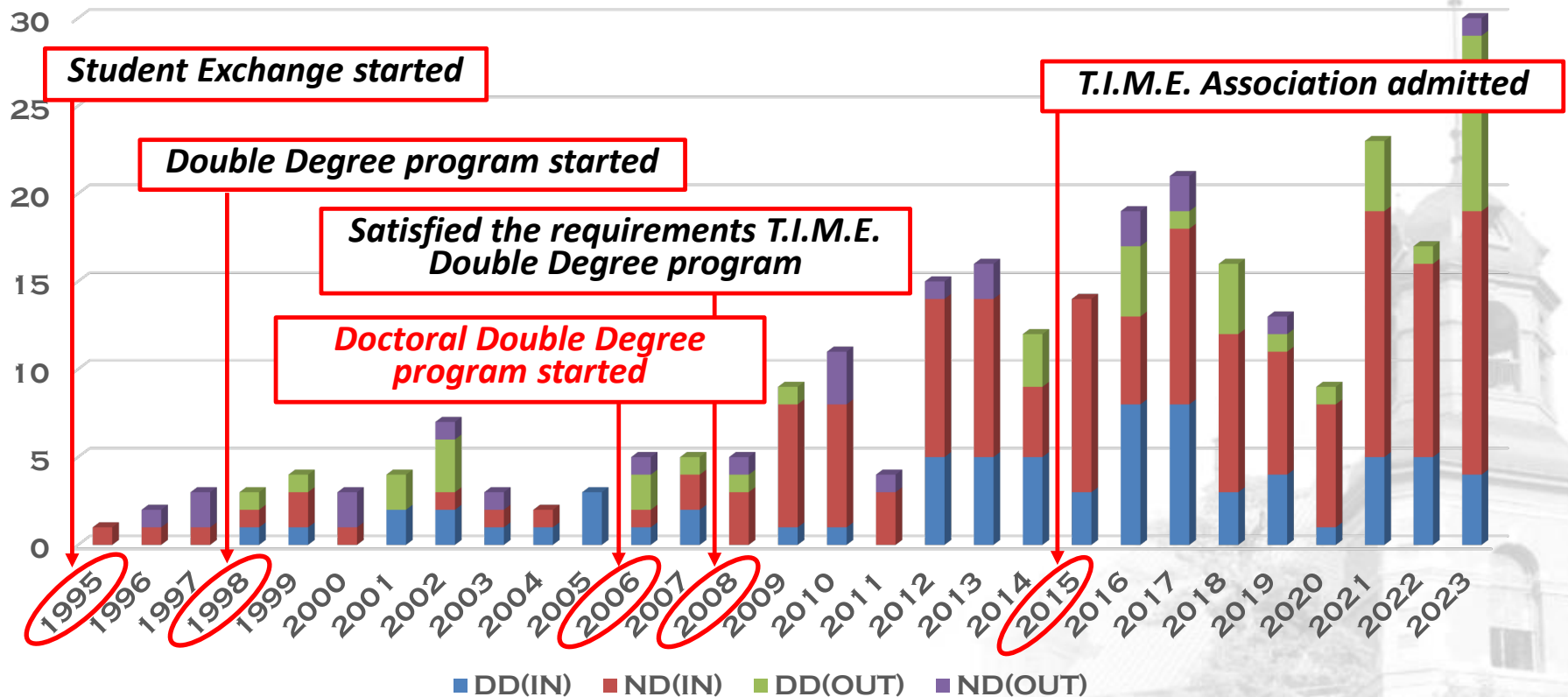
- All classes are **taught in English**.
